Our association is changing. We are presently 40% Hispanic and the percentage is growing. Our Job – is to reach the people in our communities. The instructor, Mateo Cardona, has taught Spanish at El Camino College.

Getting to know...

Rev. Mauro Duran Primera Iglesia Bautista Centro Cristiana Nueva Imagen



It was during the summer of 1975, participating as the preacher of a summer evangelistic team organized by Jack Combs, at the Headquarter office of our state, that a sixteen-year-old, hyperactive Cuban young man felt God's specific calling to start a mission in the city of Inglewood. In September of that same year, the now known as Dr. Mauro Duran, started his ministerial work at First Southern Baptist Church of Inglewood. The vision was clear: for the next forty years, (to date, 28 have already past) he was to build a Hispanic congregation capable of multiplying both in numbers and also as a church body. For that to be achieved much was required. The pastor had to grow and mature. And he did. He married and had 4 children. During the next 11 years, along with his pastoral role, he went to school: Jr. College, four year college, Seminary and University again (this time with a secular career as a goal). The church grew (*the obvious result of having a clear vision, strategy, training, goals, and planning*). With an average of 69 Baptisms per year, the church multiplied. To date, 38 churches were started abroad and 5 locally, 18 church buildings have been constructed abroad and 2 locally. 21 men and 1 woman were ordained to the pastoral ministry. Millions of Dollars were invested to do this work and none came from any outside source, it was clear to us that God was working with the church and its members. During the past 28 years Centro Cristiano Nueva Imagen (New image Christian Center) found ways to develop diverse methods of service that worked. Some of these being: Door-to-Door Evangelism, Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, Discipleship, Radio Ministry, School of Music, School of Biblical Theology, Oasis (the family ministry), The School of Psychology, Team Kid, AWANA, Contemporary Worship and The Therapy and Family Counseling Center. All of this has been done through the efforts of committed Christians who understood the mission of the church and were led by the Holy Spirit.

As a church we learned to depend on God's guidance and the wisdom given to our visionary pastor. We have learned the discipline of persistence and have enjoyed the benefit of uncompromising faith.

Some of our less known, but most effective ministries:

Oasis: the family ministry. As a professional marriage, children and family therapist, Dr. Duran created a Court certified ongoing group therapy program to reach out to a hurting community. People come from all walks of life. Some come as required by law to comply with court rulings. Some issues being domestic violence, DUI, Child abuse or endangerment, sex offenders, substance abusers, couples in the process of divorce, and a great number ordinary people seeking to understand the issues in their own lives, and that are not involved in court proceedings. We enjoy seeing them bringing their religious guards down and allowing Jesus to become the center of their lives.

Discipleship Program: This is the reason for another strong area of growth. We have great leaders as the result of this discipleship program. We use many of the Lifeway translated material, such as: Experiencing God, The Mind of Christ, Step by step trough the Old and New Testament, and also, Dr. Duran's courses written in a similar format as Lifeway's dealing with Management and Self improvement.

Any ministry focusing on children: Hispanics are known to have many children. They need help and we offer the best for them. The result, a large group of people who love children They have been trained and they invest many hours per week to minister to the children as they come to know about the Savior and Lord that saves the children and the whole family.

As a concluding note: We are also busy working with missions around the world. Dozens of our church members have gone on evangelistic crusades to other countries and continents, we have sent teams to minister in times of disaster, with "Disaster Relief Ministries", and have been working for the past seven years in a project in Guadalajara, Mexico, (1700 miles from L. A.) creating a replica of our local ministry. We already have all of the ministries that work here, there, reaching people and training them for the work of the ministry. We are now building a five-story ministry center, which will house an Orphanage, a School of Theology, an elementary school and a church.

We are exited for the given privilege of working with God as He continues to build his Kingdom. Praise the Lord!

Fue durante el verano de 1975, participaba como predicador con un equipo de evangelismo organizado por Jack Combs, en las oficinas centrales de nuestro estado, que un joven cubano hiperactivo de dieciséis años percibió un llamado específico de Dios para fundar una obra misionera en la ciudad de Inglewood. En Septiembre de aquel año, el ahora conocido como Dr. Mauro Duran, inicio esta obra ministerial en la "First Southern Baptist Church" de Inglewood. La visión era clara, durante los próximos cuarenta años (de los que 28 ya han pasado), el establecería una Iglesia capaz de multiplicarse tanto en numero de miembros como en numero de congregaciones. Para que esa visión se realizara mucho tendría que suceder. El pastor tendría que crecer y madurar. Así fue; se caso, procreo 4 hijos. Durante los próximos 11 años, simultáneamente con su labor pastoral, fue a la escuela: Colegio, Universidad, Seminario, y de nuevo Universidad (esta vez con otra carrera secular como meta). La Iglesia creció, (*es resultado obvio de tener una visión clara, estrategia, entrenamiento, metas y planes*). Con un promedio de 69 bautismos por año la Iglesia se multiplico. Hasta la fecha, se han fundado otras Iglesias en el extranjero, y cinco localmente. Se han construido 18 templos en el extranjero y 2 localmente. Fueron ordenados 21 hombres y 1 mujer al ministerio pastoral. Se han invertido millones de Dólares para lograrlo y ninguno vino de otra fuente que no fuera la congregación, siempre estuvo claro, Dios estaba trabajando con la Iglesia y sus respectivos miembros. Durante los 28 años pasados El Centro Cristiano Nueva Imagen descubrió formas para desarrollar diversos métodos para hacer el trabajo que dieron resultado; Evangelismo personal, Escuela Dominical, Escuela Bíblica de Vacaciones, Discipulado, Ministerio Radial, Escuela de Música, Escuela de Teología Bíblica, Oasis (ministerio a la familia), La Escuela Cristiana de Psicología, Team Kids, AWANA, Adoración Contemporánea, y el Centro de Conserjería y Terapia Familiar. Todo esto se ha logrado gracias al esfuerzo de creyentes comprometidos que comprendieron la misión de la Iglesia y fueron guiados por el Espíritu Santo.

Como Iglesia aprendimos a depender de la dirección de Dios y la sabiduría dada al visionario pastor. Hemos aprendido la disciplina de la persistencia y también disfrutado de los beneficios de una fe tenaz.

Algunos de los ministerios mas efectivos y a la vez menos conocidos.

Oasis Familiar, el ministerio a la familia. Como profesional en la labor de terapia matrimonial, de niños y a la familia, el Dr. Duran creo grupos de terapia familiar, certificados por la corte, con el fin de alcanzar a una comunidad doliente. Ha llegado gente de todas partes. Unos llegan bajo requerimiento legal, para cumplir con ordenes de corte, causados por Violencia Domestica, Manejar Bajo la Influencia de Sustancias, Abuso a Menores, Ofensores Sexuales, Adictos, Parejas en Proceso de Divorcio, y un gran numero de gente ordinaria tratando de comprender las luchas de sus vidas y que no tienen problemas de carácter legal. Disfrutamos verlos como bajan sus guardias religiosas, permitiéndole a Cristo ser el centro de sus vidas.

Discipulado. Esta es otra área fuerte de crecimiento. Gracias a este programa de discipulado tenemos muchos y buenos líderes. Utilizamos muchos de los material traducidos por Lifeway, como: Mi Experiencia con Dios, La Mente de Cristo, Paso a Paso por el Antiguo y Nuevo Testamento, como también, los cursos escritos por el Dr. Duran, que fueron escritos gajo el mismo formato de Lifeway sobre Administración y Motivación.

Ministerios enfocados a los niños. A los hispanos se nos conoce por tener muchos niños, tienen necesidad y nosotros les ofrecemos lo mejor. Como resultado, un gran grupo de personas entrenado que ama a los niños, dispuestos a invertir incontables horas semanalmente para ministrarles a medida que aprenden y conocen al Salvador y Señor de ellos y de sus familias.

Concluyendo. Estamos también ocupados trabajando con la obra misionera alrededor del mundo. Docenas de nuestros miembros han participado en Cruzadas Evengelisticas en otros países y continentes. Hemos enviads equipos a trabajar en tiempos de desastres, con el ministerio de "Disaster Relier" y hemos estado trabajando durante los últimos 7 años en Guadalajara, México, (a 1700 millas de distancia) a fin de crear una replica de nuestro ministerio local. Ya tenemos funcionando los ministerios probados aquí, allá, alcanzando a la gente, y entrenándolos para la obra del ministerio. Estamos construyendo un edificio de cinco pesos, para el Centro de Ministerios, que hospedara un orfanato, una Escuela de Teología, Escuela Elemental y una Iglesia.

Nos sentimos motivados por el privilegio de trabajar con Dios a medida que El continua edificando su Reino, Gloria a Dios!

Contextualized Leadership Development

We are now signing up students for the **Winter Quarter 2003** {Feb. 3rd ~ April 10th}. We are offering two courses: Mondays – Systematic Theology 1; taught by Rev. Hozell Francis and on Thursdays – New Testament 2; taught by Rev. D.D. Alexander.

The Spring Quarter 2003 will be April 21st through June 30th. We will offer two courses: Mondays – Systematic Theology 2; taught by Rev. Hozell Francis and on Thursdays – History of Baptists; taught by Rev. Artis Glass Jr.

There will be no Summer Quarter offered.

It costs just \$25 for your application fee. Classes are just \$60 each {\$70 for non-Southern Baptists} plus the cost of books.

There are three diplomas offered:

Diploma in Christian Ministry (14 courses)
Diploma in Church Planting (20 courses)
Diploma of Theology (31 courses)

These are seminary classes. You will be enrolled through Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary, Mill Valley. The classes will be held at the Association Office.

The Advisory Council, chaired by Rev. Tom Stringfellow, is in the process of joining together with the Long Beach Harbor Association and the Los Angeles Association to have a joint CLD Program. This will give us an opportunity to have the best instructors, larger classes and the ability to offer more classes per quarter. By having more classes offered, you will be able to complete your diploma in three years.

The joint CLD Program is planned to begin in September 2003. We will be moving the location at that time to be more centrally located for all three associations. We are hoping to offer classes three days per week with two classes per night.

No se ofrecerán clases de verano.

Ofrecemos tres diplomas:

Diploma en Ministerio Cristiano (14 cursos)
Diploma en Implantar Iglesias (20 cursos)
Diploma de Teología (31 cursos)

Estos son seminarios. La matricula es a través del Golden Gate Baptist Seminary, Mill Valey. Las clases se darán en la oficina de la Asociación.

La junta de consejeros, presidida por el Rev. Tom Stringfellow esta estudiando la posibilidad de unirse a la Asociación Harbor de Long Beach y a la Asociación de Los Angeles para planear el programa de Estudios para Directores. Esto nos dará la oportunidad de tener mejores instructores y más variedad de cursos cada ciclo. El poder tomar más clases durante un ciclo facilitara a obtener el diploma en solo tres años.
